June 22, 2021 PRAY. LOVE. SERVE.

Dear Co-Laborer in Christ,

Part of my responsibilities as your AMS is to provide training and equipping to our churches to assist you in taking the next step(s) God calls you to take. Let's converse about the tool(s) which will enable and facilitate the next step(s) God is calling your church and you to take for His glory and honor.

One step I exhort you to take daily is praying for each other as co-laborers in God's Kingdom. Pray for others as you would pray for yourself. Pray for others by name. Pray for others because God brings them to mind. Pray for others because of the joy and fulfillment this obedience produces. Pray for God to be visible and exalted in each of us for His glory and honor.

This summer I have had the privilege of being a summer intern with the Thomas County Baptist Association. My youth pastor at Thomasville First Baptist Church, Mr. Josh LaJeunesse, told me about this opportunity to serve, and connected me with Mr. Grant Hignight, the Associational Mission Strategist for the TCBA. Mr. Hignight has been in the ministry for many years, and it was enjoyable to talk with him and learn from him as a mentor and as a brother in Christ.

I had the joy of working with First Newark Baptist Church and Big Creek Baptist Church during their Vacation Bible Schools. I still have many fond memories of attending VBS when I was younger. VBS was crucial in helping me memorize passages of scripture and learning that the Bible was the story of God redeeming his people. I am amazed and thrilled that helping with VBS continues to teach me and continues to strengthen and grow my relationship with God.

In both VBSs, I had the opportunity to teach and share with kids key Bible stories and to tell them the epic story of God's unending love. In Matthew 18:3 (NIV) Jesus says "Truly I tell you, unless you change and become like little children, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven." Something that I noticed while teaching was the large amount of faith the kids had after hearing the lessons. As we get older, it's easier to become skeptical of Biblical truths, because we experience more lies as we go through life. We also learn to check facts before we trust them. While this isn't necessarily a harmful practice, and in many cases it is beneficial, we construct cognitive barriers that make the process of belief much more difficult. However, these young kids are curious and open to the gospel, ready to believe the truth.

By watching how they respond to God's word, it motivates me to follow the wisdom of Proverbs 3:5-6 (NIV), "Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight." The importance of trusting God in all circumstances can never be overestimated, and this outreach was an excellent reminder to put my faith in him daily. I am so thankful that I could serve and grow, by helping with another fantastic year of VBS.
