Dear Servants of the King,

I want to invite you to join me in three prayer focuses for June. God has instructed me to view these three focuses a personal priority as His servant and as parts of a whole which have equal importance. Do not underestimate the significance and value of trusting and obeying God in prayer.

Focus #1 • Vacation Bible Schools and other evangelism and outreach ministries our churches will engage. Every church in Mercer and Thomas County Associations has a mandate from the Lord to make disciples for Jesus Christ. Our Associations have resources to assist our churches to engage this mandate. Praying for each other in intercession and supplication heads the list. Serving together and sharing resources are biblical models of Kingdom work. We have Summer Interns available until their schedules are filled. Pray for our pastors, for UBS leaders and workers, for UBS participants of all ages to trust and obey what the Lord speaks to each one, for consecration and sanctification of people and resources used for these engagements, and every other specific matter God asks of you.

Focus #2 • Revival and spiritual awakening throughout our churches, our region, and our nation. Revival and spiritual awakening come when people obey God's call to repent. For many, repent is a very negative word because it requires complete submission to the Lord. Some people insist on retaining control while rejecting all God offers to those who repent. When viewed appropriately, repent is a highly positive word because of all God is and all He offers: Life, truth, love, peace, strength, hope, joy, security, adoption, and much more. Regardless the specific definitions for revival and spiritual awakening we may prefer, the outcome for both is people trusting and obeying the Lord on His terms in every facet of their lives. Brothers and sisters, the need for trusting and obeying the Lord is all around us.

Focus #3 • Graduates transitioning to the next step/phase/chapter of life. The spiritual, emotional, psychological, and physical needs of persons making these transitions are quite real, even dramatic. God has a very specific plan for each of these. Who among them acknowledges God's presence and plan in their lives? Who among them has determined to trust and obey God with their next step(s)? You and I do not get to choose for these, though we may have the privilege of pointing them to Jesus Christ through various expressions. These graduates will impact our lives, our churches, our families, and our communities through the choices they make. What scripture will you pray for those God places on your heart?

Let's trust God's heart and Word so that we are doing the work of prayer He calls us to fulfill.


